MXP2010 Conduct

The guidelines for our conduct are few and simple. You and your parents have signed the covenant and you are being trusted to follow it. The following statements about conduct are important reminders to prevent misunderstanding.

Curfew times are to be **STRICTLY** observed.

No one, under any circumstances, is to leave his or her room after curfew without permission from Josh or another leader. This is for your safety.

Guys are not allowed in girls' areas and girls are not allowed in guys' areas at any time. If there are any exceptions, it will be clearly announced.

Any room damage caused from horseplay will result in the cost of repairs being divided between those staying in the room.

Common sense tells you that we are not the only people staying in the home. Excessive noise and gathering in large groups in certain areas can keep you in trouble. **USE COMMON SENSE!**

Do **NOT** watch pay movies on TV at any time.

When you receive your wake up call in the morning, it is important that you get up immediately. You are young adults and we won't wait on you.
