What to bring/What not to bring

Important Things

Make sure you bring The Brook medical release forms notarized. You will not be able to go with us without a notarized form.

What to Bring

- Medical Release Form for The Brook (must be notarized)
- Covenant & Conduct Form (must be signed by parent & student)
- Limit one suitcase and one carry-on per student
- Bible, Notebook, and Pen
- Clothes for each day (we will be together Saturday through Thursday)
- Bathing Suit-One-piece or long, loose, dark cover up for girls and no Speedo style swimsuits for guys
- Toiletries-Soap, Shampoo, Razors, Shaving Cream, Contact Stuff, etc. (Bed linens and bath towels are provided at Host Home)
- Beach Towel
- Sunscreen (Everyone needs to wear sunscreen; no matter how many times a week you go to the tanning bed)
- Medication (adult leaders will be glad to hold this for your student)
- Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Aspirin, Pepto-Bismol, etc.
- Snacks for the road-There will be snack machines and stores so you will want to bring some extra cash
- Extra money for CDs, books, etc. (please be careful...we cannot take responsibility for lost or stolen money or items)
- Spending Money-you will be responsible for 3 meals
- Bible, Pen, and a notebook
- A great attitude

What Not to Bring:

- An excessive amount of money (we will not be responsible for lost money)
- No Bazookas
- No tobacco, alcohol, firearms, or fireworks, or knives are allowed at any time throughout the week.
- No CD Players, mp3 players, iPods, PSPs, Radios, etc. are allowed during the week. Cell phones may only be used during free time and can be confiscated if considered a distraction to the week.

Things to Remember:

Any clothes that could distract from the week (example...
